**SERVICE REPORT**

The Palestinian physician Rafik Aburamadan has worked at the Orthopaedic Department, Central Hospital in Helsingborg, Sweden 17 September 1996 - 17 March 1997 on request by the Swedish Social Board of Health and Welfare for evaluation of his competence to work as physician in Sweden according to rules for foreign medical graduates asking for Swedish authorization.

Doctor Rafik Aburamadan has shown acts that he was borned in Gaza, Palestina in 1954 and completed his medical school at the university in Kairo in 1979. Since then he has been working at the surgical and orthopaedic department in Gaza during 12 years and came to Sweden in 1992 where he fulfilled his test in the Swedish language in 1996. He has worked at the Department of Orthopaedics in Trelleborg, Sweden as an assistant doctor from 9 December 1994 to 9 January 1995 and from 1 March 1996 to 20 April 1996.

The Department of Orthopaedics in Helsingborg has 55 beds and 15 doctors, 12 of which are specialists. At the clinic we see about 20 000 outpatients annually of which 50 % are in the emergency room. We operate about 2 500 patients a year of which 50 % are as outpatients. The department treats about 360 hip fractures annually and last year we performed 420 hip and knee arthroplasties as some examples of the activities.

During his work as an assistant orthopaedic surgeon at our department during the six months, doctor Aburamadan has taken part in different activities such as emergency room, outpatient department, orthopaedic hospital wards and to a large extent in the operating rooms. He has not participated in night duties.

In the operating rooms doctor Aburamadan has assisted about 100 orthopaedic surgical procedures as a first assistant. He has also performed 23 orthopaedic surgical operations himself with a responsible orthopaedic surgeon as an assistant. Such operations are total hip arthroplasty, total knee arthroplasty, nailing of hip fractures, extraction of metallic implants, operation for hallux valgus.

Doctor Aburamadan has cooperated nicely and well both with orthopaedic colleagues, staff nurses and patients.

In conclusion doctor Aburamadan could demonstrate a considerable experience as an orthopaedic surgeon but not to such an extent that it could be immediately accepted for a Swedish authorization without a supplementary test of his basic medical knowledge and language control according to the Thule test regulations for foreign medical graduates in Stockholm.

## INTYG

Härmed intygas att doktor Rafek Abu Ramadan, har avskuterat vid Ortopediska kliniken i Malmö under tiden 94 01 17 t o m 94 11 30. Doktor Ramadan har dagligen deltagit i klinikkens verksamhet vilket innebär röntgenrund varje morgon, avdelningsrund och veckovisa konferenser med vetenskapligt inslag. Han har också följt min egen verksamhet på Ortopedmottagningen och assisterat vid ett stort antal totala höft- och knäledsplastiker. Under min ledning har han också självständigt utfört en mindre antal totala höftledsplastiker. Han har också assisterat vid ett mindre antal totala fotledsprotosoperationer.

Doktor Ramadan har visat goda kunskaper i ortopedi såväl teoretiska som praktiska.

Doktor Ramadan har också gjort en sammanställning och bearbetat ett material omfattande patienter som opererats med primär halvplastik i höftleden p g a cervikal femurfraktur resp patienter som fått halvplastik p g a komplikationer efter spikning. Detta har inneburit genomgång av ett stort antal journaler och en granskning av den tidigare litteraturen inom ämnet. Det preliminära manuskript som sammanställdes har icke publicerats. Arbetet har dock varit ett viktigt incitament till den randomiserade multicenterundersökning som genomfördes 1994 till 1997 och som kommer att påverka framtida riktlinjer för behandling av cervikala femurfrakturer hos äldre personer.
