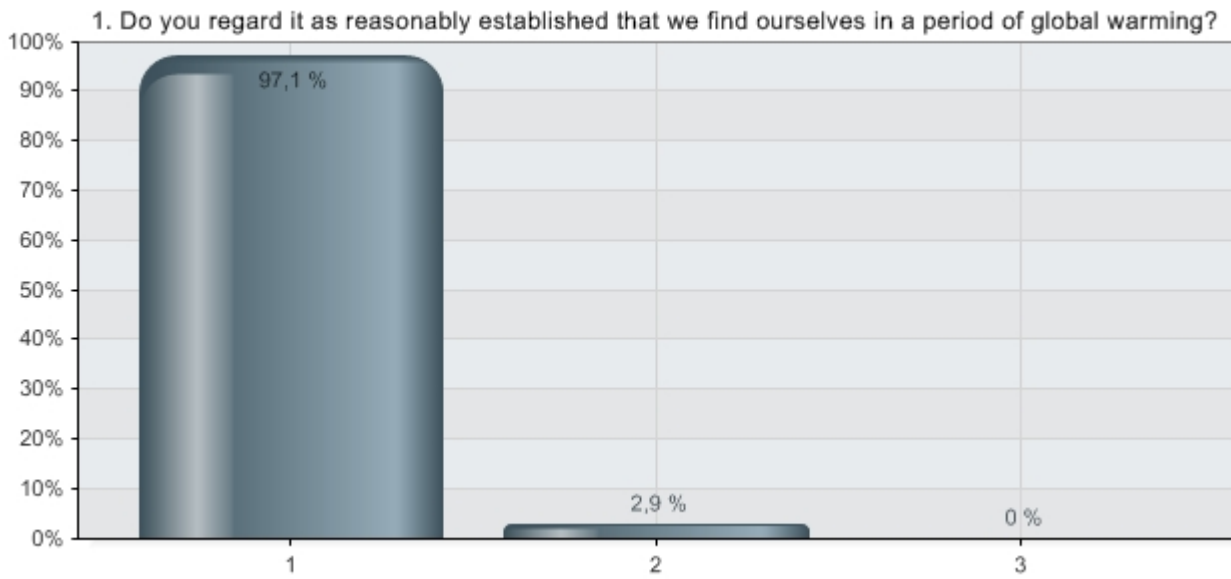

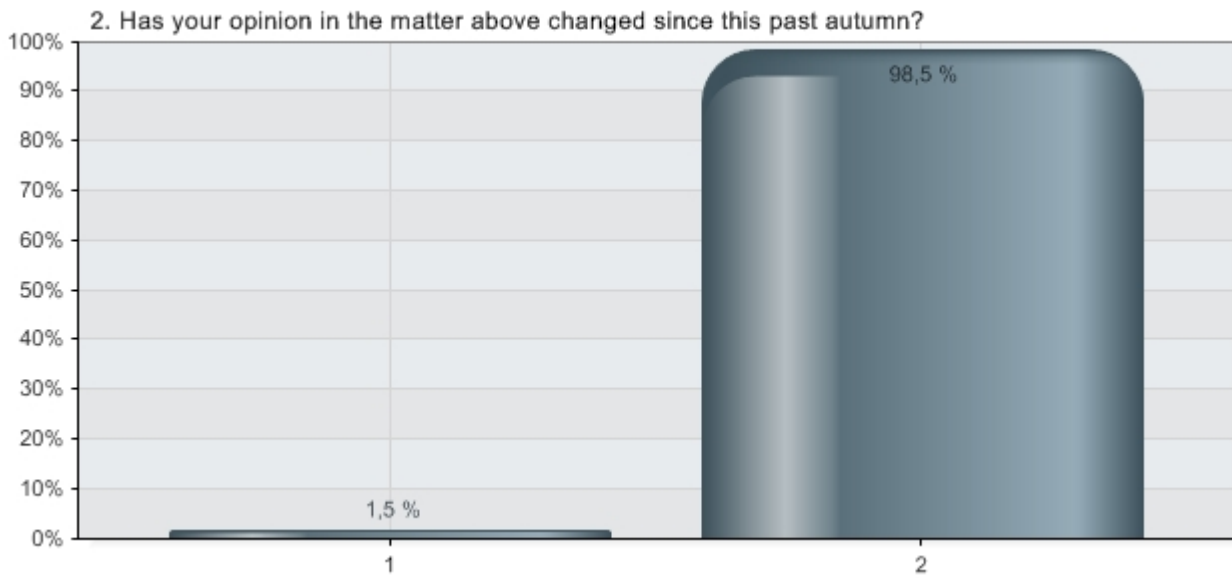

1. Do you regard it as reasonably established that we find ourselves in a period of global warming?



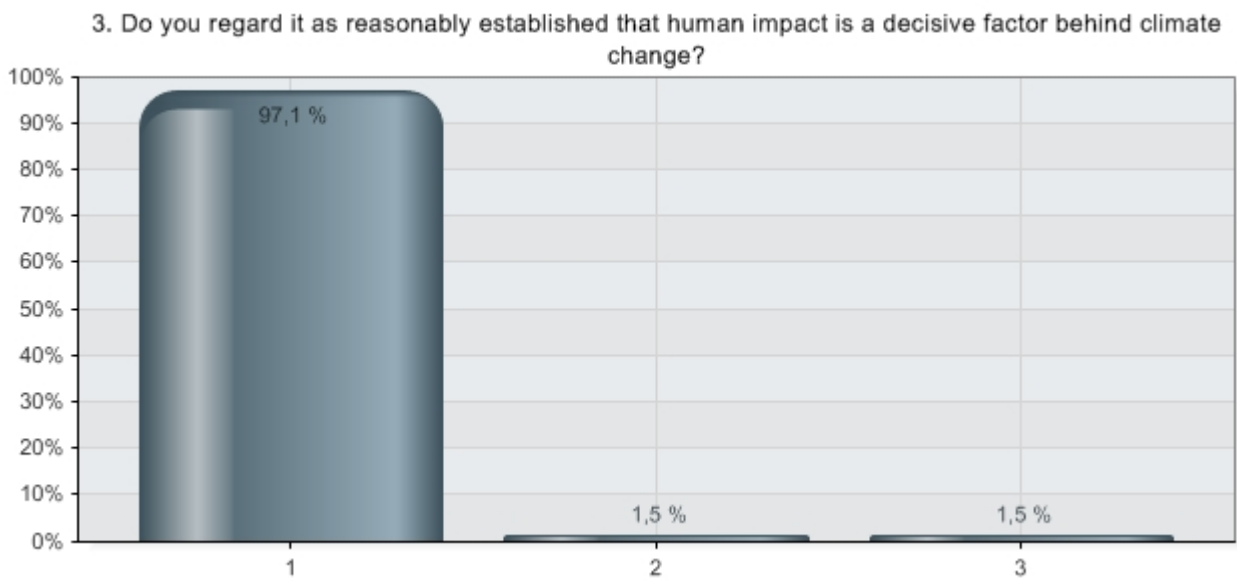

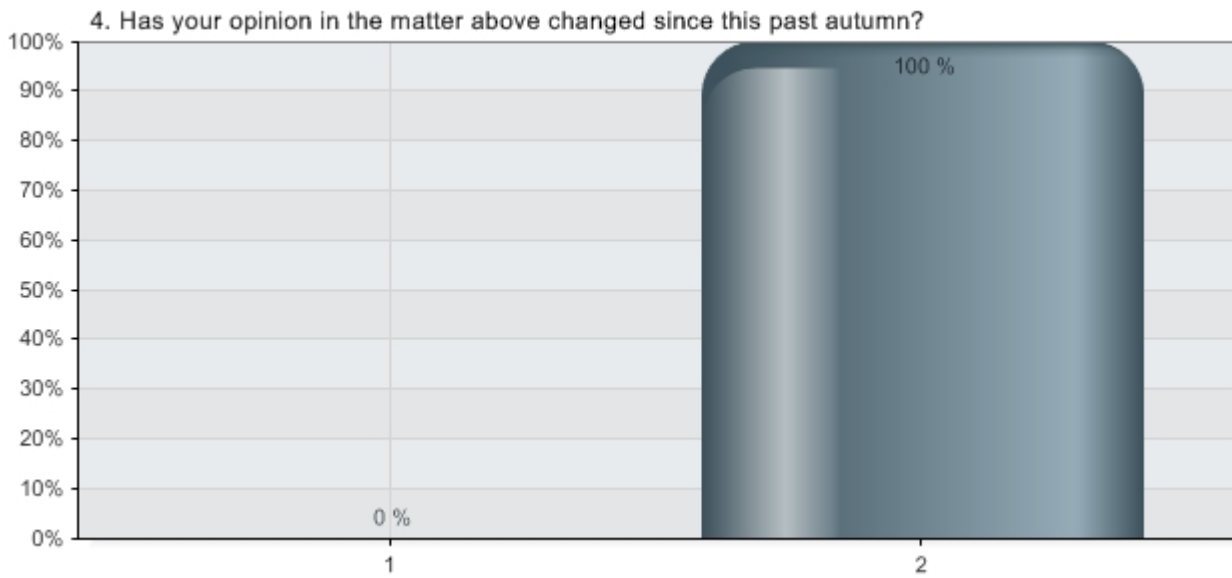

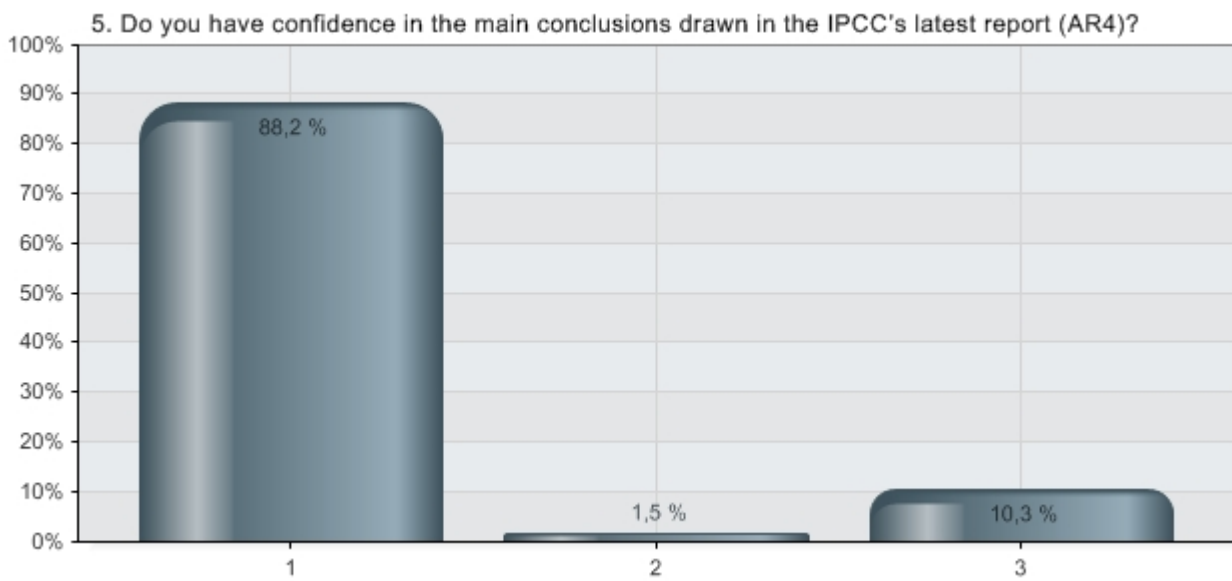

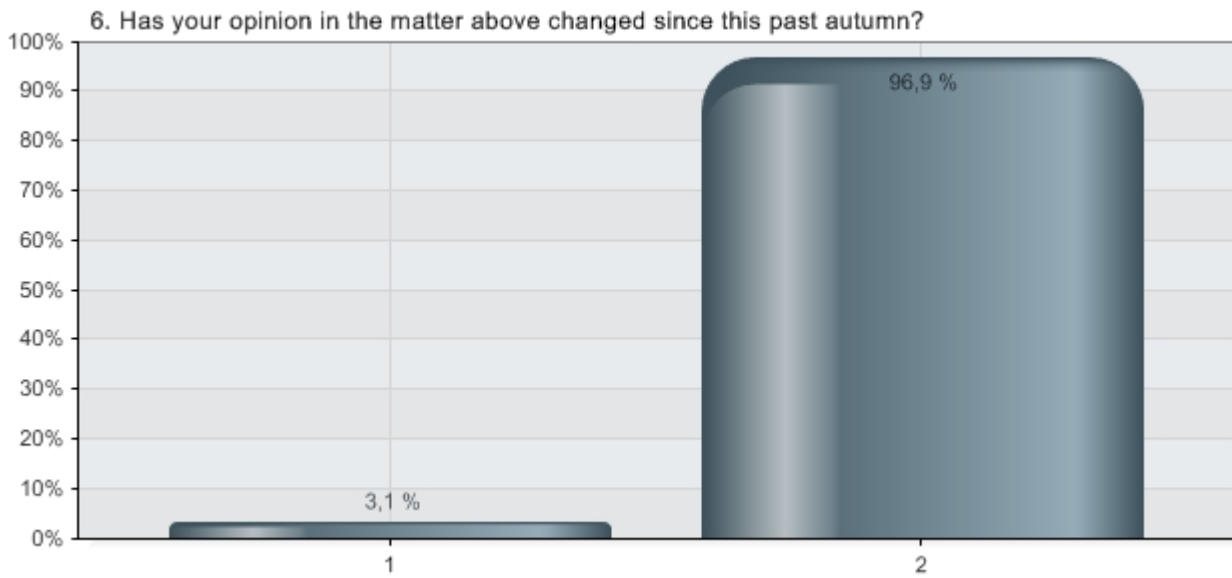

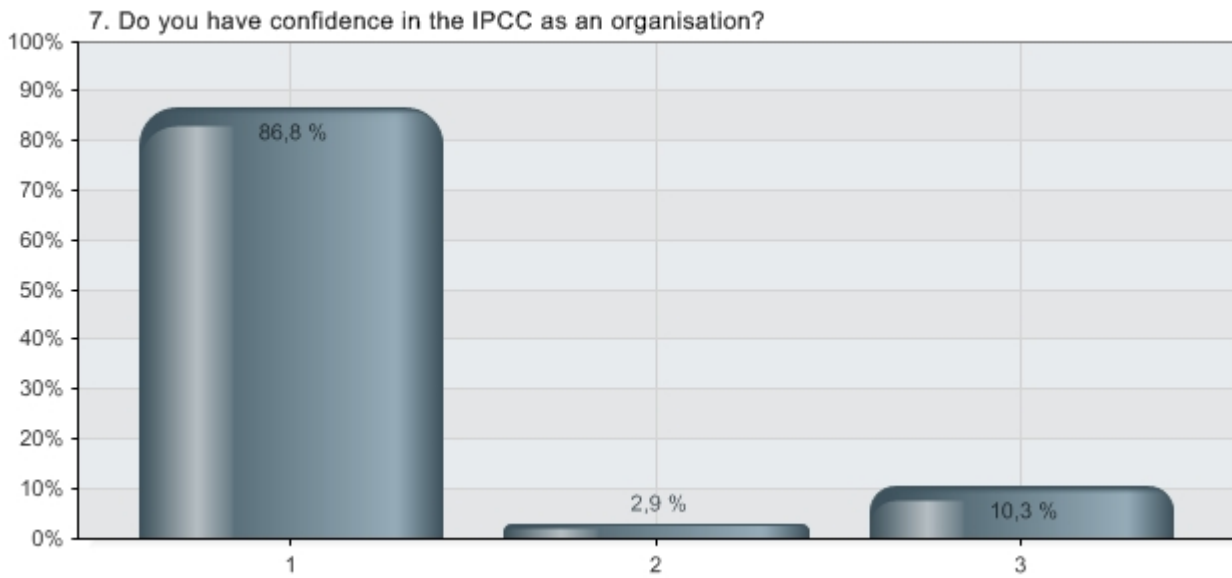

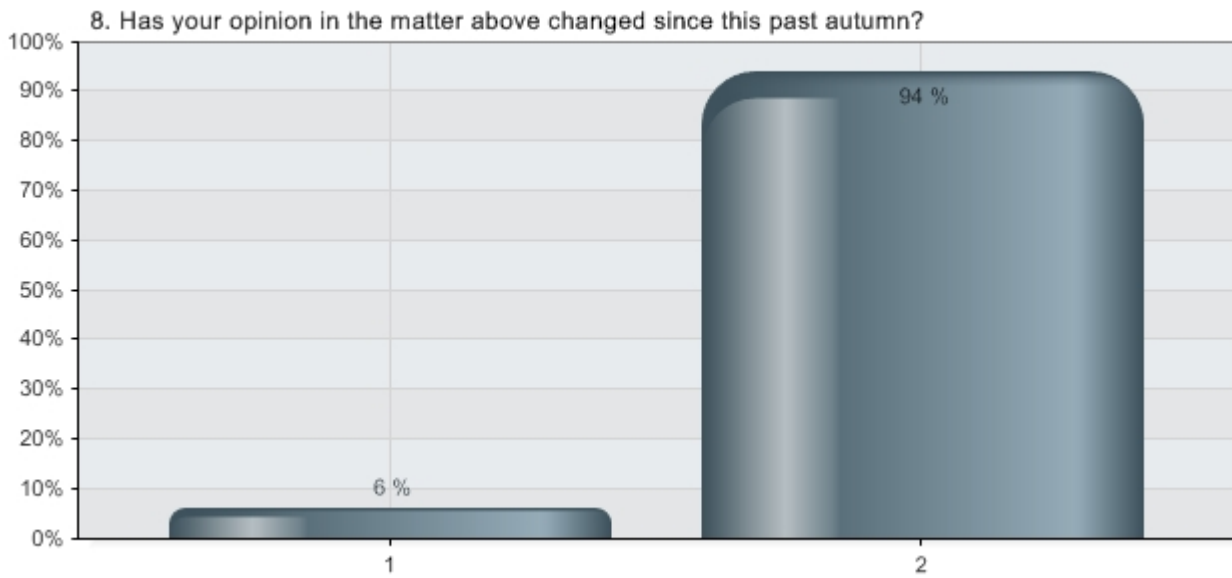

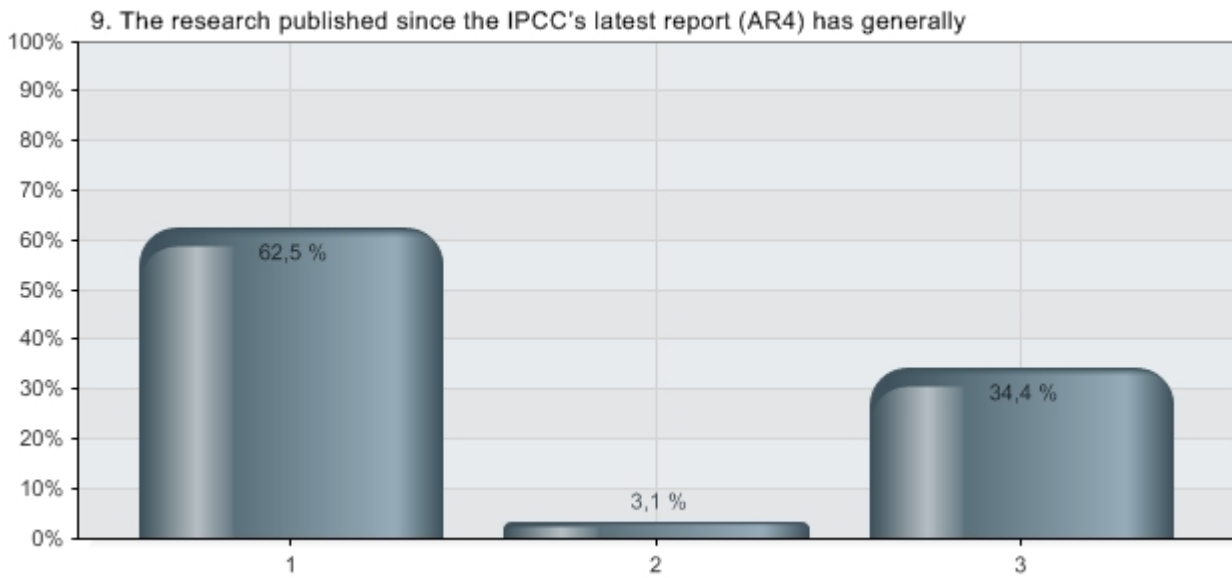

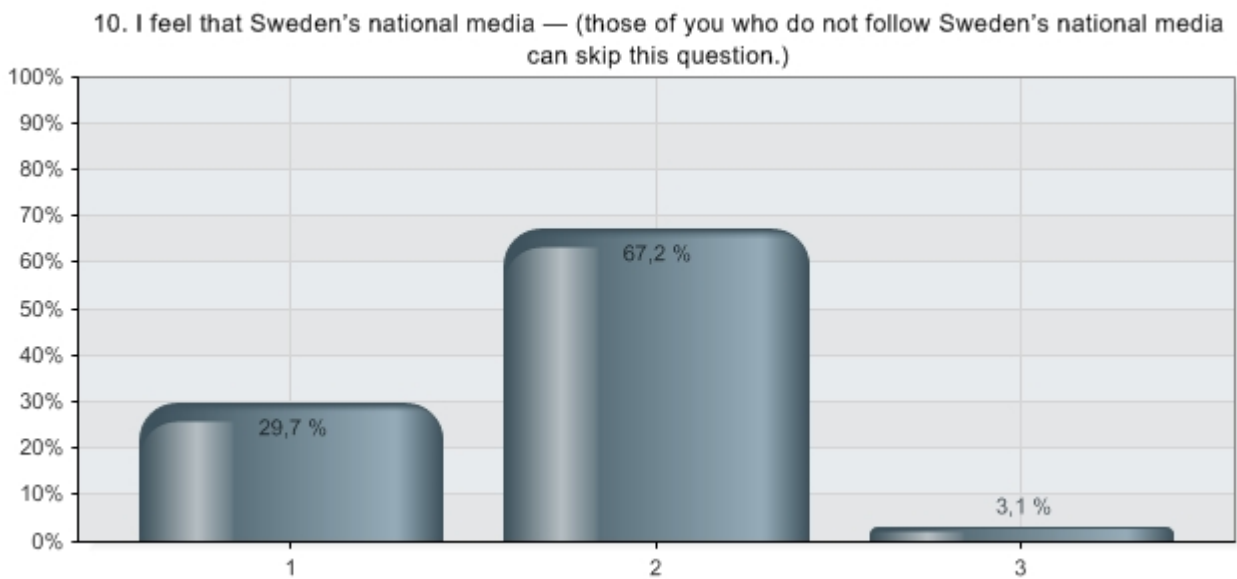

9. The research published since the IPCC' s latest report (AR4) has generally



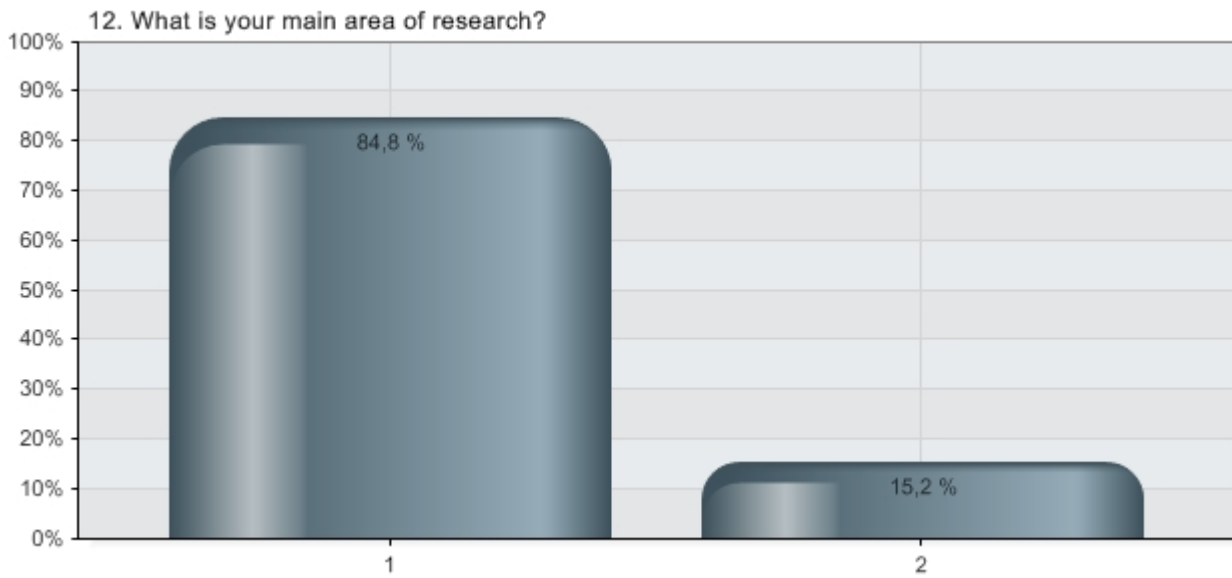
